Did you Know?

- More than 30% of American youth drop out of high school
- These rates reach nearly 50% for low-income, African-American and Hispanic students
- Dropouts earn substantially less income than high school graduates
- Dropouts are more likely to spend their lives periodically unemployed
- Dropouts rely more heavily on government assistance
- Dropouts can be found more frequently cycling in and out of the prison system
- Dropouts are more likely to abuse alcohol and drugs
- Dropouts are not adequately prepared to enter the job market and do not contribute positively to today's work force
